The picture records the fifth moment of human success on the moon, and three astronauts are driving a lunar rover to tour the Cartesian Heights. The mission was called Apollo 16. The successful landing on April 21, 1972, and the successful return on April 27, 1972. The three astronauts who performed the mission were Commander John Young, Commander Pilot Ken Mattingly, and Lunar Pilot Charles Duke. This was a mission to the moon, and the three astronauts not only brought back 200 pounds of moon rocks from the moon, but also spent 71 hours on the moon, setting a world record.

This photo was taken by a Hasselblad film camera. Encountered magical things in this mission.
